6. Every club must be projecting their progress every week, as per the scheduled
7. timetable.
8. Any club not reaching up its target as promised in the first two months may be
9. dissolved.
10. As clubs are like as an arena for like thinking minds to make a difference, every club will have to define their individual ideas in detail to not let over lap the other clubs.
11. Any special requests for aid from the management will be heard to and discussed about with the Faculty Facilitator.






